**AGREEMENT AND ORDER REGARDING FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION**

The court has issued an Order of Protection that prohibits the Respondent from possessing firearms or ammunition. The Respondent and a person who is qualified to possess firearms and ammunition within the meaning of applicable federal law have entered into an agreement regarding the firearms and ammunition of the Respondent and have presented it to the court for approval.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, that the following agreement between the Respondent and a Qualified Third Party is APPROVED regarding the possession of firearms belonging to the Respondent:

1. The Respondent is prohibited from possessing or receiving firearms or ammunition under federal law, and wishes to transfer his firearms, ammunition, or both to the following person: \_\_\_\_\_ (Qualified Third Party).
2. The Qualified Third Party does not live at the same residence as the Respondent and is not prohibited by state or federal law from possessing firearms or ammunition.
3. The Qualified Third Party acknowledges that she or he may not return the firearms or ammunition described above, or any other firearm or ammunition to the Respondent, or to any other person living at the Respondent's residence.
4. The Respondent and the Qualified Third Party understand that actual or constructive possession and/or receipt of a firearm or ammunition by a prohibited person, is punishable under federal law by a term of imprisonment of 5 to 10 years, and by a fine of not more than \$250,000.
5. The Respondent and the Qualified Third Party also understand that knowingly transferring a firearm or ammunition to anyone who is prohibited under federal law from possessing a firearm or ammunition is punishable by a fine, a term of imprisonment of up to 10 years, or both.

6. The Respondent and the Qualified Third Party declare that the above statements are true to the best of their knowledge and belief, and they understand these statements are made for use as evidence in court and are subject to penalty of perjury.
